**Narrative: A narrative on the technology planning process to include:**



District and Building Administrators met with Technology Coordinators in August 2011 to organize the Technology Planning Committee. Members of the Drew Central School District Technology Committee were chosen based on their knowledge and use of technology and their willingness to serve on the committee. Input was sought from students, parents, business leaders, University of Arkansas at Monticello community, classroom teachers and administrators. The Committee met September 1, 2011, to begin the planning process. Surveys were developed and administered to get feedback from constituent groups to determine current state of technology implementation and perceived future needs. Subsequent meetings were held to develop and finalize the plan. The plan was presented to the Elementary, Middle and High School teachers during faculty meetings in January 2012. The plan is posted on the district web site to communicate to teachers, students, parents and the community how technology will be used to improve student achievement.
